- The Tracking site is on the Kentucky Horse Park grounds where equestrian events are held and pastures.
- Entries will be accepted only on official AKC entry forms and will NOT be accepted without entry fee, separate checks for multiple entries, signature of owner or handler, and certification for TD entries.
- Bitches in season may participate in accordance with AKC Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8.
- If limit for entries is not reached in one test and is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged as stated in Section 17a of the tracking regulations.
- Preference shall be given to those dogs that have not previously earned a TD or TDX title.
- The Event Secretary will notify all entries of the result of the draw by phone or email the night of the draw. Be sure to include your phone number and email address on entry.
- The TD drawing for tracks will be at 9:00 AM with the first track to start at 9:15 AM.
- The TDX drawing for tracks will be at 10:45 AM with the first track to start at 11:00 AM.
- In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the event secretary to determine if any alternates are present. If so, space will be filled by alternates, in the order they were drawn. NO entry fee will be refunded except for an alternate who does not participate. Alternate entry checks will be shredded following the test or **returned if requested** within 7 days.
- Section 17d Test Worker Option, A club may set aside tracks for test workers from previous tests, as defined and identified by the test-giving club. This information and the number of tracks to be set aside must be published in the premium lists. Entries from the workers are to be drawn first, up to the limits shown in the table below. Once the tracks set aside for workers are filled, any remaining test worker entries will be added to the non-worker entries for the draw of the remaining tracks.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements of a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
